Administrative history / Biographical sketch

Note

David Morice Leigh Farr was born in Vancouver, British Columbia on December 19, 1922. He attended the University of British Columbia in 1940 and graduated in 1944 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree, First Class Honours in History and Economics. Immediately after graduation, Dr. Farr entered the Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve for one year after which time he relocated to Toronto and enrolled in the Masters Program (Canadian History, 1945-1946) at the University of Toronto. In 1946 Dr. Farr married Joan R. Fisher and joined Dalhousie University (1946-1947) as a lecturer in Canadian history. One year later, he was appointed lecturer at Carleton College (changed to Carleton University in 1957). During this time, Dr. Farr worked towards a Doctorate in Modern History, at Oxford University (New College and Nuffield College, 1950-1952). In addition, during the fifties Dr. Farr was employed as a Research Officer for the Defense Research Board (Summer 1955 and 1956), and Associate Examiner (1954-1955) and Examiner-in-Chief (1957-1959) for Department of Education, Toronto. Since 1947 Dr. Farr has had a career as a scholar and academic instructor/advisor at Carleton; Lecturer (1947-1952); Assistant Professor (1952-1957); Associate Professor (1957- 1961); Professor (1961-1987); Professor Emeritus (1987); Chairman, Department of History (1952-1963); Dean of Arts (1963-1969); Chairman, Council of Arts and Science of Ontario Universities (1967-1968); Member (1974-1976) and Chairman (1977-1985), Senate Committee on Honourary Degrees; Director, Paterson Centre for International Programs (1979-1985). Other academic appointments were Visiting Lecturer, University of British Columbia (Summer 1953) and Visiting Associate Professor (1957-1958), and Visiting Associate Professor for the Commonwealth Studies Centre, Duke University (1960). Dr. Farr has received honours and awards which include the John and Annie Southcott Memorial Scholarship (1943); University Graduate Historical Society Prize (1944); Research Fellowship from the Canadian Social Science Research Council (1950-1951); Studentship (1951- 1952); Short-Term Research Grant, Canada Council (1964, 1969-1970, 1976-1977); Research Grant, Canadian Institute of International Affairs (1975-1978); Research Grant, Carleton University (1976-1977, 1985-1986); Professor Emeritus (1987) Throughout his academic career Dr. Farr has been involved in various University committees such as the Interfaith Committee, Carleton

University Press Committee, and the Promotions and Search Committees, as well as many professional associations and historical interests. His participation has ranged from general member to President for such associations as the Canadian Historical Association; Ontario Historical Association; Canadian Institute of International Affairs; Canada Council; Social Science Research Council of Canada and the Social Science Federation of Canada; Canadian Political Science Association; Royal Commonwealth Society; Canadian Association of University Teachers. Dr. Farr has also had works published which include, *A Church in the Glebe*; *St. Matthew's, Ottawa 1898-1988*; a history prepared for the occasion of the 90th anniversary of *St. Matthew's Church*; *The Imperial Federation League in Canada, 1885-1894*; and *Colonial office and Canada, 1867-1887*.

Custodial history

The records were transferred to the Archives in three accessions. The first set of records were transferred from Carleton Library who received them from Dr. Farr in July 1973. The second and third set of accruals were received from Dr. Farr in October 1998.

Scope and content

Fonds consists of records created and accumulated by Dr. Farr documenting his career as a member of the History Department and an administrator at Carleton College/University, and records relating to his involvement with National associations. There are fourteen series that comprise the fonds: Carleton College (1947-1956); Carleton University (1957-1996); Department of History (1947-1987); Faculty of Graduate Studies (1972-1975); School of International Affairs (1973-1986); Institute of Canadian Studies (1957-1983); National Associations (1962-1980); Carleton International (1961-1996); Carleton Library (1962-1974); Personal Files (1947- 1998); University Affiliated Committees (1947-1979); and Non-University Affiliated Committees (1957-1994), Biographical and Obituary Information (2000-2004). Series DF-1: Carleton College

Date: 1947-1992 (date of creation)

Scope and content:

Series consists of correspondence with students and academics, course offerings and schedules, Faculty meeting minutes, pamphlets, memoranda, and newspaper clippings created and accumulated by Dr. Farr while lecturing at Carleton College. Also included 2 photographs of original staff of the College taken in 1992.

Carleton College was founded in 1942 by local businessmen and civil servants who believed education was a worthy cause. They hoped to broaden the career opportunities for young people by offering evening classes which would make it possible for them to better themselves. As a result of the Second World War, the Federal Government expanded as both men and women relocated to Ottawa to fill government positions. With this influx of person(s), an excellent opportunity arose to establish a post-secondary school institution; the first post-secondary school institution established in Ontario since the nineteenth century. With the end of the war, Carleton College began to expand and one year later Dr. Farr was appointed lecturer in history and lectured between 1947-1952, after which he was appointed Assistant Professor until 1957. Scope and content:

Series consists of correspondence with students and academics, course material, departmental meetings, invitations, pamphlets, and reports. The material was created created and accumulated by Dr. Farr while lecturing in the History Department..

Carleton University began instruction in history in 1942. In 1952, the Department of History was created as an administrative unit of the Faculty of Arts and Sciences. In 1957 the Faculty divided into two divisions; the Division of Sciences, and the Division of Humanities and Social Sciences. The Department of History joined the Division of Social Sciences. Then the University reorganized into four faculties including the Faculty of Arts in 1963, with the History Department joining the Faculty of Arts where it remained until 1976. In 1976, the Faculty of Arts divided into two faculties; the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Social Sciences, and history became a department of the Faculty of Arts. Dr. Farr began teaching history at Carleton as a Lecturer (1947), became Assistant Professor and Chairman (1952-1957), Associated Professor (1957-1961), and full Professor in 1961.

Scope and content:

Series consists of correspondence with students and academics, course offerings, Faculty Graduate Board meetings, memorandums pertaining to the Faculty of Graduate Studies. This material was created and accumulated by Dr. Farr while lecturing at Carleton University.

In 1954, a Senate Committee on Graduate Studies met to consider the acceptance of candidates for Masters programs. This Committee which became the School of Graduate Studies in 1960, was created as an administrative unit of the Faculty of Arts and Science. In 1963, when Carleton reorganized into four faculties the Faculty of Graduate Studies was created. Eleven years later,
